SETTLEMENT APPROVED

ROYAL WINNIPEG BALLET SCHOOL and BRUCE MONK CLASS ACTION

If you were a student at the Royal Winnipeg Ballet School (RWB) at any time between 1984 and 2015, and you were photographed by Bruce Monk in a private setting while you were a student, then you are entitled to make a claim for a payment from the settlement of this class action.

The RWB has paid \$10 million to settle this action. After deducting legal fees and administration expenses, the net settlement fund will be paid to eligible claimants. Payments will include \$1,000 for the eligible student's health services, up to \$2,500 for the student's family members, and the balance of the settlement fund will be allocated based upon the level of harm each eligible student endured.

Claims must be made by **no later than February 28, 2023.**
